

SKEINO - Moon Shawl - color options



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Five Skein Knitting Kit

using an I-cord yarn
68% feather light Baby Alpaca
10% Fine Merino
22% Nylon

Bulky - Weight
easy yarn changes

GAUGE:
4 Stitches per inch
Garter Stitch

on # 11 Needle
circular 28"

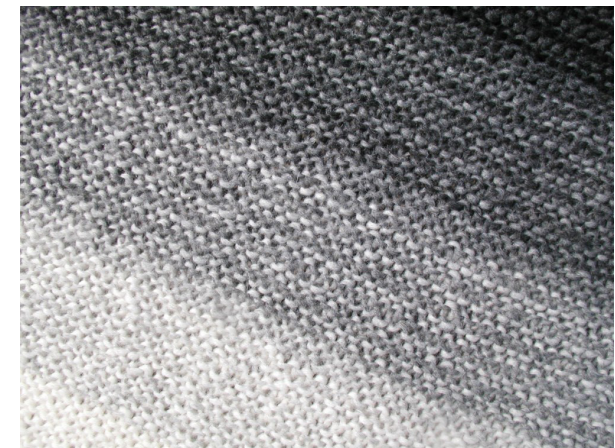
5 skeins
120 yards each
total of 600 yards
9 oz. (258 grams)

finished size
47" (bias) x
40" (cast on/bind off)

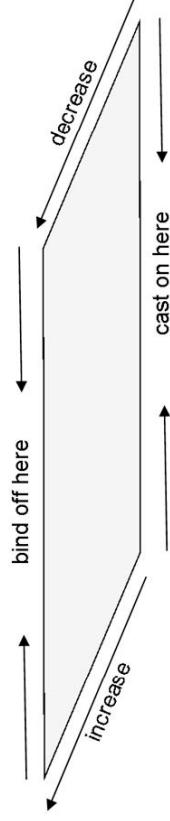

MOON SHAWL



SKEINO - MOON SHAWL PATTERN



Size: 47" (bias), 40" (cast-on, bind-off)

Needles: Size US 11 (8 mm) 24" circulars or straight needles

Yarn: SKEINO, 68% Baby Alpaca, 10% merino, 22% nylon; 5 skeins, 120 yards each

Gauge: before blocking: 4 stitches per inch, after blocking: 3.5 stitches per inch

Pattern Stitch: Garter Stitch Bias

Row 1 (and all RS rows): K1, K2tog, K2tog, knit to the last 3 stitches, Kfb, Kfb, K1

Row 2: K all stitches

These two rows makes 1 garter stitch ridge on the right-side of the work.

Cast-on 124 stitches with Color #1

Setup Row (WS): Knit across all stitches.

Begin working Garter Stitch Bias stitch, (working all RS rows as Row 1, and all WS rows as Row 2).

Work 9 ridges in Color 1 (cast-on, Setup Row, plus 16 rows)

Next 10 ridges (20 rows): Alternate 1 ridge in Color #2, and 1 ridge in Color #1
Break yarn for Color #1, and work 5 ridges (10 rows) in Color #2

Next 10 ridges: Alternate 1 ridge in Color #3, and 1 ridge in Color #2
Break yarn for Color #2, and work 5 ridges in Color #3

Next 10 ridges: Alternate 1 ridge in Color #4, and 1 ridge in Color #3
Break yarn for Color #3, and work 5 ridges in Color #4

Next 10 ridges: Alternate 1 ridge in Color #5, and 1 ridge in Color #4
Break yarn for Color #4, and work 9 ridges (18 rows) in Color #5

Bind-off loosely, and weave in ends.
