Feather & Fan Afghan

KNITTING KIT
using five different yarns
total of 1380 yards

Yarn 1 : BLUE FACE LEICESTER
275 yards
100% Blue Face Leicester

Yarn 2 : BIELLA - 275 yards
60% Nylon / 40% Super Kid Mohair

Yarn 3 : PARMA - 275 yards
80% Merino / 20% Silk

Yarn 4 : GLITTER BOUCLE
275 yards
62% Merino / 18% Lurex / 20% Mohair

Yarn 5 : MERINO - 280 yards
100% Fine Merino

Needle size # 9 -10
3 1/2 Stitches per inch
In Pattern Stitch

SIZE
48 X 60 inches

FEATHER & FAN AFGHAN

SKEINO

FEATHER & FAN AFGHAN

MATERIAL: 5 different skeins of yarn
total of 1380 yards
circular knitting needles
9 (or 10) 36 inches long

GAUGE: 3 1/2 Stitches per inch

NOTE: The Afghan is knitted lengthwise.
The basic pattern is Feather & Fan.
The first and the last 5 stitches of every row are knitted, which creates a Garter Stitch border.
The center part of the afghan is knitted in pattern repeats (6 rows each).
Yarn changes creating the fringes on the short sides of the afghan: keep each end 8 inches long (end and beginning of yarn).
Use the 5 different yarns for 3 rows each throughout.
Work the yarn repeat until you run out of the first yarn.
The leftover yarns are being used for the last rows in Garter Stitch on each of the long sides of the afghan and if you wish for additional Fringes.

PATTERN

PROVISIONAL CAST ON

Cast on 208 stitches with an odd yarn from your stash.

At the end of your work, you will need to pick up these stitches for the final Garter Stitch border.

PATTERN REPEAT

Start working the pattern repeat with yarn #1 and follow the base pattern.

BASE PATTERN (6 rows):

1. K all
2. K5, P198, K5
3. K5, * [K2tog] 3 times, [YO, K1] 6 times, [K2tog] 3 times*, repeat *to* 10 more times, K5
4. K all
5. K all
6. K5, P198, K5

Work each of the five yarns for three rows throughout (yarn 1 to 5), which will do 15 rows.

2 yarns together form one pattern repeat:

Yarn #1 = row 1-3 and yarn #2 = row 4-6
For 30 rows (= 5 pattern repeats) you will work 2 yarn repeats.

Repeat the base pattern until you run out of the first yarn.

Keep all ends from the yarn changes 8 inches long for the fringes.

GARTER STITCH BORDER

For the beginning and the end of your work you will need to create the Garter Stitch border from the leftover yarn.

Divide this yarn into two equal portions.

Use one portion to knit as many rows as you can and bind off loosely.

Pick up the stitches from the provisional cast on side and use the second half of your leftover yarn for this side. Bind off loosely.

The remaining yarn can be used for additional fringes. Cut 16 inch strands and thread these ends through the edge with a crochet hook. Tie the fringes.

Here are the five yarns again:

Yarn 1 : BLUE FACE LEICESTER
275 yards
100% Blue Face Leicester

Yarn 2 : BIELLA - 275 yards
60% Nylon / 40% Super Kid Mohair

Yarn 3 : PARMA - 275 yards
80% Merino / 20% Silk

Yarn 4 : GLITTER BOUCLE
275 yards
62% Merino / 18% Lurex / 20% Mohair

Yarn 5 : MERINO - 280 yards
100% Fine Merino
