knitted top down
Two Skeins Knitting Kit

using our **PAOLA** yarn
100% Extra Fine Merino

and

our **PISA GLITTER** yarn
78% Baby Alpaca
20% Merino / 2% Lurex

**Worsted - Weight
2-strand knitting**

GAUGE (after washing):
8 Stitches and 16 Rows
= 4 x 4 inches
in Pattern Stitch
on # 11 (8 mm) Needle
circular 28"

total of 420 yards
(2-strands)
7 oz. (200 grams)

finished size
56" wide, 35" deep
(after washing)

This pattern is designed by Bjorn Coordt.

Wind both skeins into a ball and work with both yarns together (2-stand knitting). At the end you can work several rows (optional only with the Paola yarn) by using a US #7 (4.5 mm) circular needle.

ABBREVIATIONS

(K-YO-K) = increase 2 sts by knitting this sts (do not slide this st from the left needle, make a YO and knit the same st again)

K2tog = knit 2 together (decrease one st)

P2tog = purl 2 together (decrease one st)

YO = yarn over (increase one st)

Sl = slip one stitch knit wise

WK = wrap the yarn from the front to the back and knit the back leg of that stitch

KB = knit bar below (increase one st)

NOTE: Place a marker for the center stitch if you like.

Cast on 3 stitches

1. row: WK, (K-YO-K), Sl
2. row: WK, K3, Sl
3. row: WK, (K-YO-K) 3times, Sl (11 sts on your needle)
4. row: WK, K9, Sl
5. row (setup row): WK, K2, KB, (K-YO-K), KB, K2, KB, K2, SL (17 sts)
6. row: WK, K15, Sl
7. *row: WK, K2, KB, (YO, P2tog)2x, K1, PM, (K-YO-K), K1, (P2tog, YO)2x, KB, K2, Sl (21 sts)
8. row: WK, K3, (YO, K2tog)x3, K1, (K2tog, YO)x3, K3, Sl (21 sts)
9. row: WK, K2, KB, K7, (K-YO-K), K7, KB, K2, Sl (25 sts)
10. row: WK, K23, Sl*

Rows 7 to 10 are the pattern repeat. The number of stitches will grow 8 stitches every repeat. The 3 edge stitches need to be worked all the time the same way in Garter Stitch. The center stitch needs to always be in the center.

Work until you run out of the first yarn. This will be the Pisa Glitter yarn.

If you would like to add a nice border keep knitting with the Paola yarn using a #7 circular needle as follows:

Work the edge stitches as usual. Continue this row and make a YO after each stitch and almost double the number of stitches on your needle. Keep knitting as many rows as you have yarn or as you like.

Bind off loosely. Keep the last stitch and crochet across the width of your shawl with the Paola yarn. Crochet tight and only as many stitches as you need for a great “not growing” edge. Wash you piece by hand and spin gentle. Use the low heat setting on your dryer and run it for three minutes. Place your damp shawl onto a flat surface and shape your shawl perfectly for the final air drying. The knitting texture should be open like a net.
